THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PASTORAL MINISTRY AND PASTORAL CARE

Pastoral Ministry

"Pastoral Ministry" is when an appointed leader (also known as a "pastor," "shepherd," "priest", "bishop", "elder", "rabbi", etc.), guides people in meeting their spiritual needs through The Messiah. The objective of Pastoral Ministry is to restore hope, faith, and love in the hearts of God's followers. The majority of ministering that takes place within an Assembly of Believers is "Pastoral Ministry". In Pastoral Ministry, the minister helps to connect Believers to The Messiah. "Pastoral Ministry" is bringing The Compassion of The Messiah to people, to help them meet their emotional, mental, physical, and spiritual needs. "Pastoral Ministry" also serves to help others to recognize their gifts, empowering them to use these gifts in the service of others." Examples of "Pastoral Ministry" include bereavement support, visiting the sick, nursing home ministry, ministering to the jailed, feeding the hungry, helping the homeless, weekly worship services, communion, etc.

Pastoral Care

"Pastoral <u>Care</u>" is the ministry of spiritual care, education and counseling. The main focus is on the nurturing of each person's spirit. A pastor, in the role of a spiritual nurturer, is the one who actually performs pastoral care. Every aspect of a pastor's interactions with the people in the pastor's realm of influence is a part of Pastoral <u>Care</u>. "Pastoral <u>Care</u>" is a <u>type</u> of "Pastoral <u>Ministry</u>". "Pastoral <u>Care</u>" has been described as, "individual and corporate patience in which trained pastoral caregivers support people in their pain, loss, and anxiety, and in their triumphs, joys and victories.

Keep in mind, in both "Pastoral Ministry" and in "Pastoral Care", the word "Pastor" comes from the Latin word for "Shepherd". A "pastor" is to be a "shepherd" or "caretaker" of God's flock. "Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, serving as overseers – not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not greedy for money, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock" (1Peter 5:2-3).

PROGRAM

This course positions students to chaplaincy and prepares them to do supportive ministry in an extension setting as an endorsed representative of The Body of The Messiah. It introduces students to the history, theology, and practice of chaplaincy ministries as it exposes them, through study and practicum, to the various chaplaincy settings such as, hospitals, prisons, hospice, military, police, industry, college campus, and sports.

In this course, the students will learn the importance of being equipped to witness to all people in all types of crisis situations. Believers must understand the importance of serving God, by serving His people through venturing into the world. Like Yeshua, we are called to incarnate The Lord in the workplace, in the marketplace, in the hospital, in the prison, in long-term care facilities, in the struggles of death, change, and when in harm's way. As ordained representatives of God, chaplains are called, gifted, endorsed, and equipped to take "The Ministry of Reconciliation" to people who may be cut off from the traditional setting. In this course, students will explore the calling to chaplaincy, the professional standards of chaplaincy, and the students will be able to better discern which particular form of chaplaincy they are called to.

- You will be required to do a practicum upon completion of your training.

The Certificate Program at Tabernacle Theological Seminary will prepare students to obtain the professional certifications they need to gain employment or to advance in the particular field of study. A certificate may be awarded as the student progresses in an undergraduate or graduate degree level program.

Students who desire to obtain expertise in a field without investing the time needed to earn a college degree may earn a college certificate. Depending on the subject, students may complete a college certificate program in six months to a year because these programs focus on one disciple and do not require the general education study requirements of the degree programs. Upon completion of a certificate program, students will generally receive a certificate of completion which may also be transferred to degree programs.
